

## 2022 DAN RICE DAYS PARADE

Once again, we are looking forward to your attendance in our **DAN RICE DAYS PARADE** on **Saturday, August 6 , 2022**

The **DAN RICE DAYS PARADE** check-in will begin at **10:00 a.m.** at the Girard High School parking lot off of **Rice Avenue**. Please enter the school grounds from this point, as all other entrances will be closed. When you arrive, please check-in and obtain your position. Position markers will be located in the parking lot.

The parade will start **PROMPTLY AT 11:00 a.m.** The parade will proceed south on Rice Avenue (Route 18) to Main Street (Route 20) where it will proceed east on Main Street and disperse at Church Street.

Restrooms are available in the concession stand facility at the Girard High School Athletic Field prior to the start of the parade.

For those units who wish to perform during the parade, there will be lines marked on Main Street, in front of the announcer's table. All performances are to be held in that designated area. Performances during the rest of the parade route must be kept to a minimum in order to keep the parade flowing.

*Please use discretion when throwing candy to the sidelines, as children are endangered dashing into the street.*

**All ANTIQUE VEHICLES** will be placed near the front of the parade in order to reduce overheating engines. **ALL HORSES** will be placed near the end of the parade for safety reasons, unless equipped with bags. Riders are responsible for removing animal waste from borough streets.
